## Destinations and Fares

**Day out in Cornwall. Leave Saltash at 0824, 0931 or 1053** (Monday – Friday)  
All fares are Adult Off Peak Day returns.  
Child (under 16) fares are half the Adult fare.  
(Railcard fares in brackets)

**Saltash – Looe**  
£5.00 (£3.30) 55 minutes

**Saltash – Truro**  
£9.00 (£5.95) 1 hour 10 mins.

**Saltash – Penzance**  
£9.50 (£6.25) 1 hour 50 mins.

**Saltash – Newquay**  
£7.80 (£5.15) 1 hour 40 mins.

**Saltash – St Ives**  
£9.50 (£6.25) 2 hours

**Saturdays (all off peak)**  
Catch the **0828 0928 1001 or 1044**

**Sundays (all off peak)**  
Catch the **0925, 1026 or 1126** Westbound

**Day out in Devon. Head east to Ivybridge, Totnes, Teignmouth or Dawlish** or a little further to **Exeter**, direct every weekday at **0935**.

**Get a Devon and Cornwall Railcard and save a further one third off the normal Off Peak fare (Off Peak is usually after 0900).**

Costs just £10 and is valid for 1 year. Another adult can travel with the same discount and up to 4 children travel for £1 each. **Westbound trains are Off Peak after 0820.** D & C Railcards are available from Plymouth Station with proof of address only (no photo needed).

## Travelling from Saltash Station

**Tickets.** Saltash is an unmanned station. You do not need to buy a ticket before you board. You should buy a ticket either on the train or at your destination. You will not pay more for your ticket because of this. Exactly the same tickets are available with the same rail card discounts as at a normal ticket office. Make sure you buy your ticket to or from Saltash, we need the passenger numbers.

**Information.** Timetables are available at the station along with other information. Real time information points are available on both platform and also have buttons to talk to the National Rail Enquiry Service and the Emergency Services. There are more leaflets in the Guildhall.

**Parking.** The approach road to the station is for rail users only and parking is FREE. Town Centre Car Parks are FREE on a Sunday and after 1600 Mon to Sat. .

### **Season Tickets can help save you time and money.**

A Weekly Season Ticket between Saltash and Plymouth is just £8.40, compare this to paying £2.70 per day totalling £13.50. Weekly Season Tickets are available on the train as long as you have a photocard, Monthly or longer are only available at staffed stations. An Annual Season Ticket also doubles as a Devon and Cornwall Railcard and can be traded in if no longer required. Phone for more advice.

**3 or 4 can travel for the price of 2 using GroupSave** (+ kids for a £1 each)

Not valid on CrossCountry trains and on some dates.
