

## Travelling from Saltash Station

### Tickets

Saltash is an unmanned station. You do not need to buy a ticket before you board. You should buy a ticket either on the train or at your destination. You will not pay more for your ticket because of this. Exactly the same tickets are available with the same rail card discounts as at a normal ticket office. Make sure you buy your ticket to or from Saltash, we need the passenger numbers.

### Information

Timetables are available at the station along with other relevant information. A real time information point is available on Platform 2 (the little BLUE Box) and will give information on trains within the next hour.

### Parking

The approach road to the station is for rail users and parking is FREE. There are two disabled parking bays. There is also on-street parking close by, and 'Pay and Display' all day parking is available at Alexandra Square Car Park, only a 2 minute walk.

### GENERAL NOTES APPLY TO ALL DAYS AND DATES

**TRAINS INTO CORNWALL:** Devonport, Dockyard, Keyham and St. Budeaux stops as indicated. Some call at Menheniot as indicated. All stop at St. Germans (except 1043 to Penzance on a Sat) Most stop at all stations to destination

**TRAINS FROM CORNWALL:** Menheniot stops as indicated, All call at St. Germans. After Saltash the St. Budeaux, Keyham, Dockyard, Devonport stops are indicated.

### **Saturdays** (all off peak)

### **Sundays** (all off peak)

Catch the **1041 or 1131** Westbound (& **0920** until 7th September - NEW extra early service)

**Day out in Devon. Head east to Totnes, Teignmouth or Dawlish** or a little further to **Exeter**, direct every weekday at **0933**.

**3 or 4 can travel for the price of 2 using GroupSave** (+ kids for a £1)

**Get a Devon and Cornwall Railcard and save a further one third off the normal fare (off peak, usually after 0900).**

Costs £10 and is valid for 1 year. Another adult can travel with the same discount and up to 4 children travel for £1 each. **Can currently be used on the 0821 to Penzance and 0833 to Newquay.**
